

Basketball Rankings System – Instructions & Information

The basketball rankings system has been in place for a few years now so this won't be a new process for many schools. However, if you have never used the system before this brief guide may help answer some of your questions. Please note: once scores have been entered and saved, you cannot edit them. **Please do not enter the game again.** Simply send an email with the correction and I will edit the information for you.

Step 1 – Accessing the Rankings System

From the ASAA homepage, click on “Enter Basketball Results”. You will then see a login screen. The username and password to be entered here are unique to this system and are different from your online registration username and password. Please contact the office if you need this information again.

Step 2 – Entering a Game Score

From the Rankings Main Menu, click on [R1 – Enter/View Game Result](#). You will be brought to a screen that has a drop down menu at the top and a link to Insert New Game.

***** In order to prevent having duplicate entries, it is useful to have an agreement that the winning team enters the score. The system is designed to prevent duplicate entries, but if there is even a typo in the score or the date, the duplicate entry will appear.**

Click on [Insert New Game](#)

You will see the following screen.

- Right Side:** "This info is helpful for rankers especially if you are playing a non-ASAA team in a tournament" (points to Game Type dropdown)
- Bottom Left:** "The school that has logged in will automatically appear here; therefore it will always be the ASAA member school's senior team. **JV teams will never be listed here.** Always indicate whether you were home or away and put your score in the box." (points to Home Team dropdown)
- Bottom Right:** "If you played against another ASAA senior varsity team, select that team from the drop down menu here. Remember, only select from this list if you played this school's senior team." (points to Versus ASAA Team dropdown)

If you played against an ASAA member school's **junior varsity team** or **against an out-of-province team**, you must type that school's name here. For example: **Harry Ainlay JV** team or **Regina High**. If you know the classification of the team, select that from the drop down menu provided.

OR

Versus NON ASAA Team

Score: Enter the opposing team's score here

Game Notes:

Game notes are for both teams: the team that enters the score can put whatever they like and once the game appears on the list; both teams involved in the game will have access to an edit button which allows both teams to go in and add or edit notes. **It is important that each team indicate who wrote what note so the rankers know what team the notes refer to.** For example:

Harry Ainlay: Played without starting Centre

Strathcona: Starting forward fouled out with 8 minutes to play

Always click **Update Game Result** to save the entry.

****Please ensure that for all games involving junior varsity teams you list the JV team in the free type are as indicated in the picture above.**

Step 3 – Viewing Games Option 1

From the drop down list where you see please select, you will get a list of all the classifications. If you are interested in seeing games where 1A boys teams played, you will select "Basketball 1A Boys" and click on View Game. This will give you a list of ALL games involving 1A boys teams, no matter the classification of the opposing team. That is, you will see the game if a 1A team played a 3A team. That same game will also appear on the list if you select "Basketball 3A Boys" from the drop down menu.

Viewing Games – Option 2

From the Rankings Main Menu, click on [R3 – Team Record or Team vs. Team Comparison](#)

You will then see this screen.

If you would like to see how two teams have matched up against each other, you can select both teams, one in each of the drop down menus. For example, if I choose Harry Ainlay in the first box and Ross Sheppard in the second and click on **Compare/View Team(s) Now**, I will see the following:
