INSTRUCTIONS

All the information requested in this application must be completed and supporting letters of recommendation received by February 1 annually for the candidate to be considered for the May induction into the High School Sports Hall of Fame. The completed nomination form and support materials are to be sent to the ASAA office via email (info@asaa.ca) or by regular mail (four copies please if sending by regular mail). Once the nomination form is received by the Executive Director all actions necessary to the selection process shall remain confidential. All information submitted shall be retained by the ASAA.

A completed nomination must be accompanied by letters of recommendation from the nominator and two others from appropriate individuals from the nominee's related high school career. These letters should substantiate the individual accomplishments or contributions to high school sports (**only** these three letters will be considered for the nomination). A limited number of newspaper clippings, magazine articles and statistics as applicable should be included to help support the nomination. These materials should focus on high school accomplishments and contributions and should be listed in chronological order.

GENERAL CRITERIA

Nominees must exemplify the highest standards of sportsmanship, ethical conduct and moral character.

The categories of coach, athlete, athletic administrator, and special achievement are included on the nomination form for expediency in understanding the primary area in which an individual is to be considered for his or her achievements in high school sports.

To further explain, coaches would be considered on the merits of their high school coaching achievements only, athletes on the basis of their high school athletic achievements (with consideration also given to accomplishments following high school), and administrators on the merits of their service as a high school athletic director or athletic administrator. The special achievement category is for individuals who have made contributions to high school sports in some capacity other than those previously mentioned. These may include but not be limited to such areas as officiating, media recognition, long-standing volunteers or staff serving school sports. The special achievements may also include team inductions.

All candidates will be judged on their significant and or long-term contributions to high school sports in Alberta. While many have served their schools or zones well they must have long and distinguished careers worthy of this recognition.

The Alberta High School's Sports Hall of Fame was created in the ASAA's 50th year as a means to recognize, preserve, and honour the heritage of high school sports in Alberta. Many individuals have made extraordinary contributions and have had superb accomplishments in high school sports. The ASAA Sports Hall of Fame honors the contributions and accomplishments of those individuals who are worthy of Provincial recognition.
