

Progression to Provincials 2015

Zones are allocated team berths as follows (**maximum 2 per zone** with exception of host zone):

* wildcard berths based on ASAA policy which gives points to top three placed teams from past three years on the basis of 5 for first place in category, 3 pts for second and 2 pts for third. In the event of a tie, the zone with the highest placing team last year is given the berth.

Additional Berths:

Any zone with 15 teams registered in a category (e.g. 1A/2A boys) with ASAA and competing in the zone championship will receive an additional berth to provincials. However, no zone, other than the host zone, can exceed two berths per category.

Individual Competitors:

1. Any girl who scores 90 or better at their zone championship is eligible to attend provincials regardless of how they placed at zones.
2. Any boy who scores 76 or better at their zone championship is eligible to attend provincials regardless of how they placed at zone.
3. Zones with one tournament per gender: in addition to players who may be on a team attending provincials, the next best **three** qualifiers are eligible to attend provincials as individuals. These individuals will compete for the individual championship only and will not be eligible to score points for their school team.
4. Zones with split tournaments per gender: in addition to players who may be on a team attending provincials, the next best **two** qualifiers are eligible to attend provincials as individuals. As above they cannot score points for their school.
5. At zone competition qualifying tournament, players must show competency in the sport by scoring under 135 for 18 holes. Any player shooting more than 135 will not be eligible to compete at provincials.

Note: For individuals shooting between 135 and 140, it will be at the discretion of the Golf Commissioner and the Executive Director to allow participation at Provincials.

Alternates:

Each school team should submit the name of an alternate that can be used in the event of unforeseen circumstances. At no point can any school have more than four students competing on one day **for team play**. The athletes listed in the team portion of the zone registration form, are the only ones eligible to compete for the team banner. Inclusion of alternates can only occur based on the criteria noted in policy (circumstances beyond their control i.e. illness, injury, family emergency) following the approval of the Commissioner and the Executive/Deputy Director.
