The Alberta *Milk Every Moment* Scholarship Application Criteria

The ASAA invites scholarship nominations for students currently registered in ASAA member high schools and planning to graduate in June 2016.

The award is for students who **Milk Every Moment**, achieving a balance in school, home and community life.

Nominations

ASAA member schools may submit a nomination for one male and one female only. The application form **must be signed** by the school principal/assistant principal.

Eligibility

The nominated student must:

- 1. Be a grade 12 student registered in an ASAA member school and must also meet all ASAA eligibility criteria as set out in the 2015/16 ASAA Policy Handbook pages 37 to 45.
- 2. Participate in athletic activities. This can be active participation in school intramurals throughout the year, being a member of a school sports team or participation in an activity that is not a school sport, such as dance, ballet, water polo, fencing, hockey, karate, etc. Please note that priority will be given to those student athletes who have participated in an ASAA sanctioned sport.
- 3. Demonstrate an attitude of fair play and sportsmanship while participating in sport and social activities.
- 4. Show personal development with involvement in activities other than athletics and academics. For example, community work, hobbies, clubs, youth programs, etc.
- 5. Plan to attend a post-secondary educational facility in Canada.
- 6. Be an Alberta resident.

Note: Once the scholarship committee has selected the recipients, applicants will be notified and required to provide to the ASAA a photocopy of their official Alberta Education High School Transcript, verified by the school principal's signature.

Requirements

- <u>Four complete copies</u> of the application must be submitted in the following order: application form, resume, references and essay, with each copy stapled at the top left corner (no folders or binders please).
- 2. **Application form** must be completely filled out and signed by both the student and school principal/assistant principal.
- 3. **Resume** must be completed in the format provided (two pages maximum).
- 4. Letters of reference/support (two maximum) must accompany the scholarship application. Letters of reference submitted must provide evidence of participation in sport, fair play, sportsmanship, and personal development, and support the student's attitude of never stopping to learn and achieve. References can be from school staff, coaches, youth leaders or mentors.
- 5. Write an essay exploring what sports and healthy eating mean to you. Be sure to include personal experiences and note that a title is required. The essay should be a minimum of 250 words to a maximum of 500 words with the word count listed on the bottom of the essay. This essay in part or in full may be published in an ASAA newsletter, Alberta Milk Milking Times newsletter and/or in one of the social media venues (websites, Facebook, Twitter, etc.).
- 6. Applications failing to meet the above requirements will not be considered for the award.
