May your journey be filled with memorable moments and may you leave Kainai with new friends and positive energy from this beautiful land.



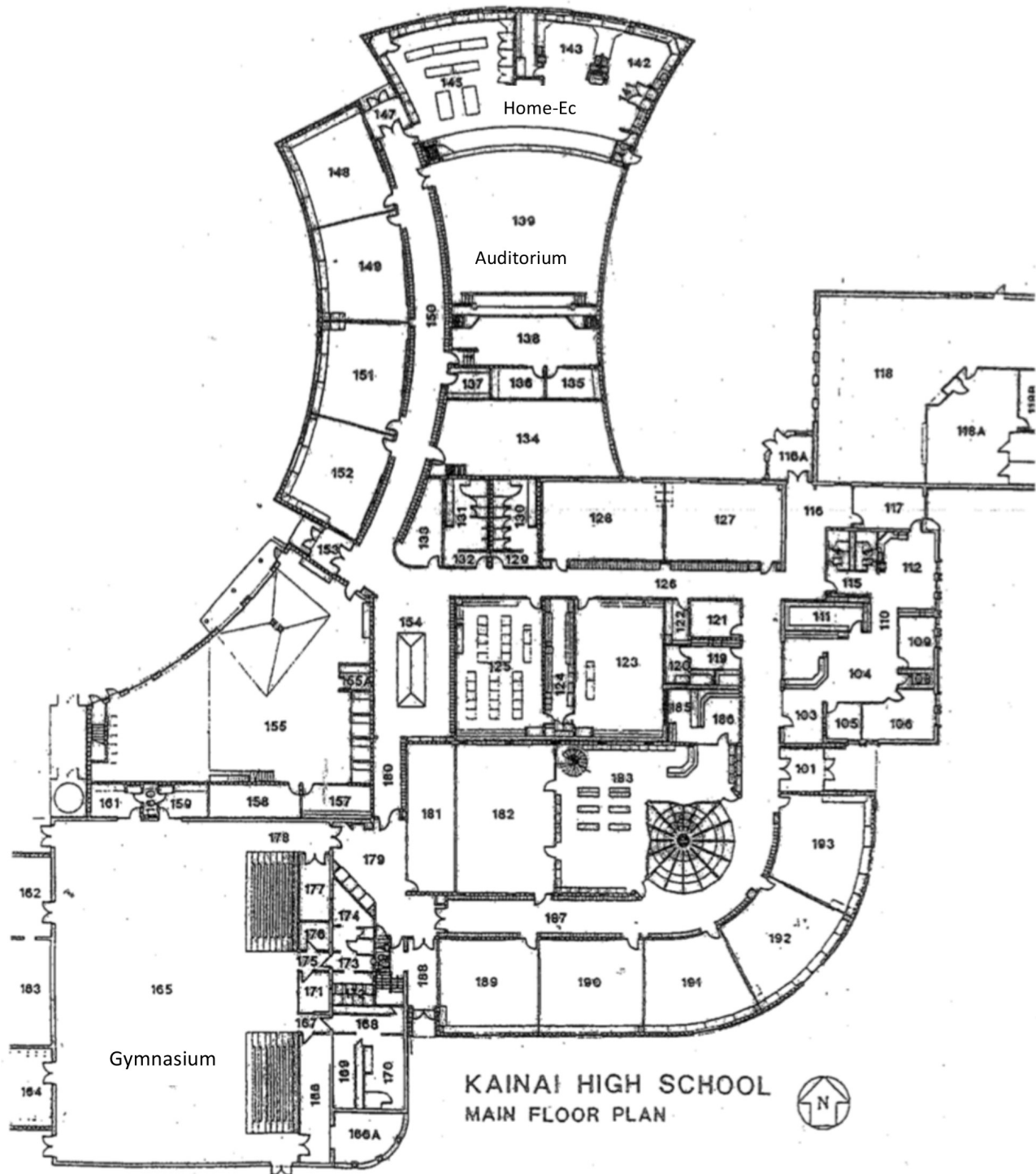
