Re: ASAA Provincial Football Tier IV South Representatives

Dear ASAA Football Teams:

This memorandum is to address the selection process for the Tier IV Region 2 representatives at the 2017, 2018 and 2019 Alberta Bowls.

The structure of the quarter final bracket provides Region 2 with the opportunity to select two teams to represent the region. Given that there are three leagues at the Tier IV level competing for two playoff spots, a rotation was developed in order to determine which two teams would be selected from the three leagues. This rotation was designed based on a draw conducted by ASAA Football Commissioner George Grant, ASAA Executive Director John Paton and Football Alberta Associate Executive Director Tim Enger. The rotation will be implemented for the 2017, 2018 and 2019 Alberta Bowl with one league receiving a berth to participate and the other two leagues hosting a playoff game **one week before the quarter finals** to determine the second representative.

The rotation schedule is set as follows:

2017	Region 2A – Rockyview Region 2B – Big Rock Region 2C – Big Sky	Rockyview	Winner of 2B (H) vs. 2C Big Rock (H) vs. Big Sky
2018	Region 2A – Big Rock Region 2B – Big Sky Region 2C - Rockyview	Big Rock	Winner of 2B (H) vs. 2C Big Sky (H) vs. Rockyview
2019	Region 2A – Big Sky Region 2B – Rockyview Region 2C – Big Rock	Big Sky	Winner of 2B (H) vs. 2C Rockyview (H) vs. Big Rock



As per the rotation schedule, the Region 2A representative will receive a berth to the quarter finals. The Region 2B berth will be awarded to the winner of the 2B vs. 2C game for the corresponding year.

The game determining the recipient of the 2B berth must be hosted in accordance with this rotation schedule at least one week before the quarter finals. Should any league cease to exist or new leagues be added, the rotation will be adjusted as required.
