**Re:** Rule modification adopted for ASAA High School Wrestling for the 2013-14 Season

---

The rules for high school wrestling for the 2013-14 season will follow the new 2013-14 CAWA rule book with the addition of the following ASAA adopted rule. For ASAA high school competition we will adopt a 10 point, rather than the listed 7 point superiority rule.

### RATIONALE:

From viewing the CIS University and some Jr. high competitions, it appears that the 7 point superiority rule would end a match rather quickly. At a developmental level with a large variance in skill and experience level this is undesirable. By going with the 10 point superiority rule we will maximize the on mat experience for wrestlers in high school. The CIS has also adopted the 10 point superiority rule for its competition. Additionally, the National VP Technical for the Canadian Amateur Wrestling Association has recommended the 10 point superiority rule for competition at the local and provincial high school level.
