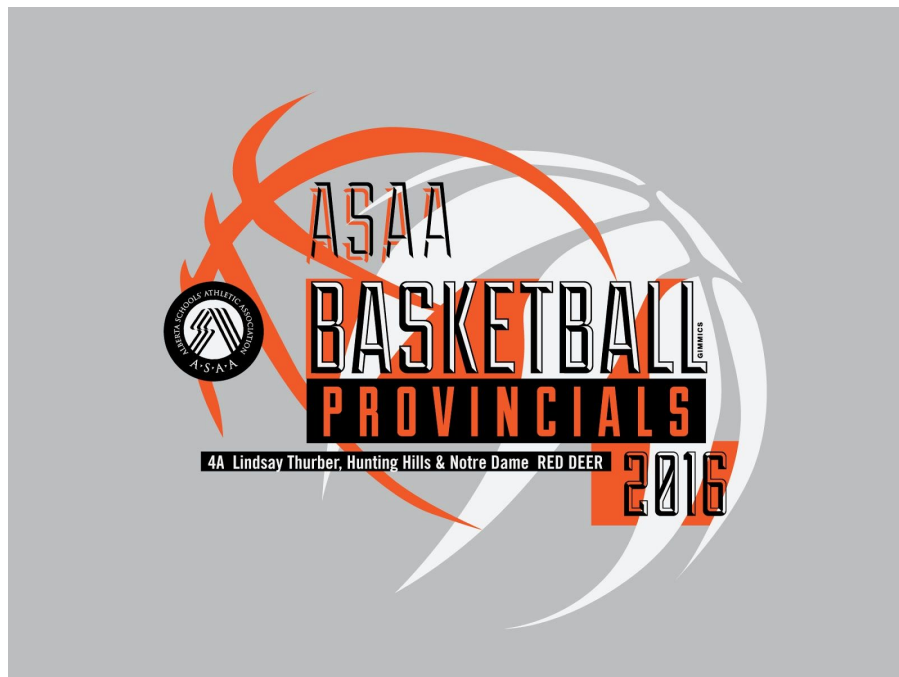

Registration/Fees:

Tournament fees for the 4A Championships have been established by the ASAA at **\$460/team**. This fee is based solely on ABOA costs. Teams will register for the tournament as well as order their banquet tickets through the official host website. Team registration must be completed by Monday, March 14th at 12:00 noon.

Please have your team registration and banquet ticket cheque for the Coaches Meeting at 9:30pm on Wednesday March 17th. Please make cheques payable to **Notre Dame High School**.

Pay it Forward Loonie Fee:

Just a reminder to all schools that new this year, as voted on and approved by the Board at the AGM, there will be a ‘Pay It Forward Loonie Fee’ assessed to all participants at provincials. This fee will be added to all provincial registration forms on the tournament website.

The Pay it Forward Loonie Fee (pg 64 of 2014/2015 ASAA policy handbook) – states that “each provincial championship will charge an additional \$1 for each participating student and remit those funds to the ASAA office after the championship. Those funds will be directed to the ASAA scholarship fund to recognize student athletes who give back to their school and communities by either coaching or officiating in school or community sport.”

Banquet/Official Ceremonies:

The official opening of the tournament will be held in conjunction with the banquet on Thursday, March 17th starting at 9:30am in Gym 1 at Hunting Hills High School. Attendance at the banquet/opening ceremonies is compulsory for all team members and coaches. Teams must wear attire that identifies them as a team.

Tickets are \$25/person with a maximum of 18 tickets allowed per team. Tickets must be paid for a time of registration.

The banquet will include opening comments by ASAA executive members, words of inspiration via a guest speaker (TBA), and brunch.

Photos:

All teams are expected to get team photos and individual photos done on Wednesday, March 16th. Photos will take place at Notre Dame High School and Lindsay Thurber High School on a first come, first serve basis from 4:00 pm – 7:00 pm. If needed, Josten's will be available Friday, March 18th from 9:00 am -12:00 pm at Notre Dame for any team unable to get their pictures taken on the Wednesday.

Teams are requested to appear for photos with consistency – all in uniform or all in warm-up attire.

Warm-up Basketballs/Practice Sessions:

Practice and Warm Up Balls will be provided at each location. Teams will not be required to bring their own warm up or practice balls.

Practice times will be offered at Hunting Hills, Notre Dame, Lindsay Thurber and St. Francis Middle School. Team practice times will be accommodated in one-hour blocks on Wednesday, March 18th, beginning at 3:30 pm. Sign up for practice times will be first come first serve basis via a Google document that will be shared with coaches at **10am on Tuesday March 15th**. A detailed list of practice times and locations will be located on the host website after sign up has been completed.

Coaches/Captains Meetings:

These will be held in the Auditorium at Notre Dame High School the evening of Wednesday, March 18th @ 9:00pm. All teams must have a representative present at each meeting.

Webcasts:

There will be webcast coverage for every game of the championships. Links for the webcasts can be found on the host website.

First Aid:

Teams must provide their own medical supplies and plan to do their own taping. Ice will be available upon request. Tournament Organizing Committee members will be available to assist you in accessing further medical attention if required.

Hospitality/Concession:

All facilities will operate a concession and/or have food vendors available on site for fans and athletes. All concessions will follow the new ASAA Nutrition Policy.

Hospitality rooms will be provided by the Organizing Committee for coaches and officials at each facility. We ask for your cooperation in ensuring that these rooms be utilized by, essentially, adults-only – coaches, officials, and organizers. They are intended as informal and friendly respites for participants and we request that criticisms/complaints (if any) be aired in more private areas.

Awards Presentations:

All “presentation games” will be held at Lindsay Thurber High School and awards will be presented immediately following the game. These include Championship, Finalists, 3rd Place, 4th Place, and Consolation Championship. In accord with ASAA, Team Sportsmanship Awards will be presented by the ASAA to the recipient school at a time shortly after the competition.

Sportsmanship:

Consistent with ASAA values, a strong emphasis on and recognition of sportsmanship in both individual and teams will be highlighted. The Sportsmanship Committee will award individual pins in recognition of sportsmanship-like actions through the tournament, and will forward their recommendation for the Team Award to the ASAA for later presentation.

The Sportsmanship Committee will be comprised of members of the Organizing Committee as well as a representative voice from the ABOA.

Discipline and Misconduct:

Breaches of the ASAA Code of Ethics are treated seriously and, as hosts, we are required to immediately report to the ASAA office any breaches that come to our attention. A portion of the ASAA Code of Ethics states “Any conduct, including, but not limited to ejections, fighting, drugs and alcohol use, that results in dishonor to the athlete, the team, the school or the ASAA will not be tolerated” (pg 28)

Grievance/Discipline Committee:

While it is our hope that a panel of this nature is not required during this event, a Grievance/Discipline Committee will be in place to review any and all concerns that may occur. These will include appeals of application of ASAA policy (eg. ejections), as well as tournament concerns. Contact information for immediate resolution will be presented at the Coaches' Meeting.

Code of Ethics/Sportsmanship

We remind all about the standards of behavior and performance for which the ASAA stands – applying the team's members as well as supporters. Fair play and sportsmanship of team members are expectations of the ASAA and the Organizing Committee, and the responsibility of coaches. A reminder that artificial noisemakers are not allowed at ASAA events. While hosts will monitor and address unacceptable spectator behavior, we will – if necessary – call on team delegates to assist with their fans.

Parking:

Hunting Hills:

- A section of the student parking lot will be blocked off for bus parking (west side of school).
- Overflow parking will be available at the Collicutt Centre (North East side parking lot) as well as along Lockwood Avenue.

Lindsay Thurber:

- During school hours, buses may drop off only in the bus lane directly in front of the school. Buses that are parking must use the lane at the north end of the building.
- After school hours (4pm and later) busses may park in the bus lane
- Overflow parking will be available in the gravel lot, directly north/west of Thurber (behind of the Memorial Center).

Camille:

- During school hours, students may be dropped off in the bus lane at the south entrance of the school (directly outside the gym) but must park in one of the 2 designated Lindsay Thurber areas.
- After school hours (post 4pm), busses may park in the bus lane.

Notre Dame:

- A section of the Notre Dame northside student lot will be sectioned off for busses (directly beside the gym)
- Overflow parking will be available along Lockwood Ave or Lee Street

St. Francis:

- Students can be dropped off in the bus lane directly in front of the school
- Parking will be available along Lindsay Ave
