Event Capacity: Maximum of 16 Unified Basketball teams and 32 Unified Bocce/Bean Bag Toss (BBT) teams. Please submit your registration form on time to ensure your spot in the sport you are registering for.

Event Format: Schools can register Unified Basketball and Unified Bocce/BBT teams for this event. The top placing Unified Basketball and Unified Bocce/BBT teams from each school will earn points for their school and a winner will be announced at the end of the Jamboree.

Notes:

- Unified Basketball teams will <u>only</u> compete in Unified Basketball
- Unified Bocce/BBT teams will compete in both bocce and bean bag toss
- The same students <u>cannot</u> be registered on both Unified Basketball and Unified Bocce/BBT teams
- Unified Bocce/BBT teams can be registered in <u>either</u> a competitive or recreational pool
 - Teams in the competitive pool will play in round robin and championship games and earn points for their school; teams in the recreational pool will only play round robin and will not earn points for their school total.
- All Unified Basketball teams will be considered competitive (regardless of skill level) and will
 have the opportunity to earn points for their school total.
