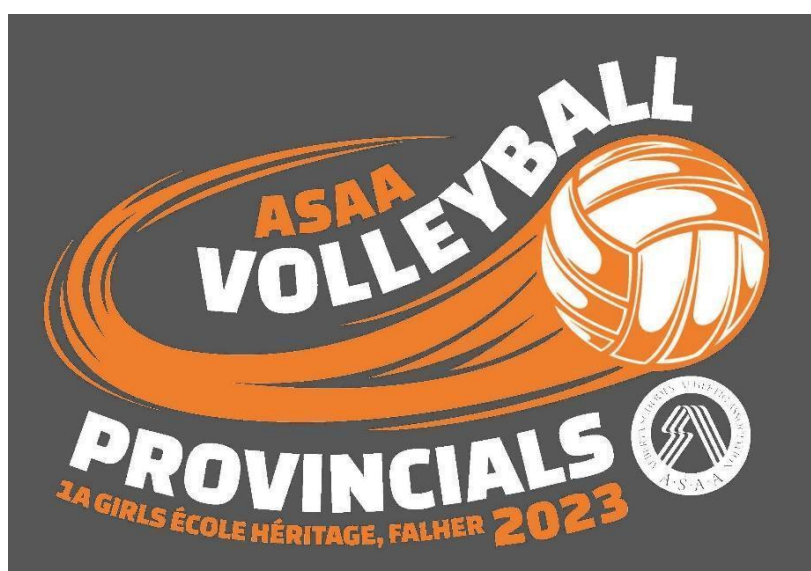

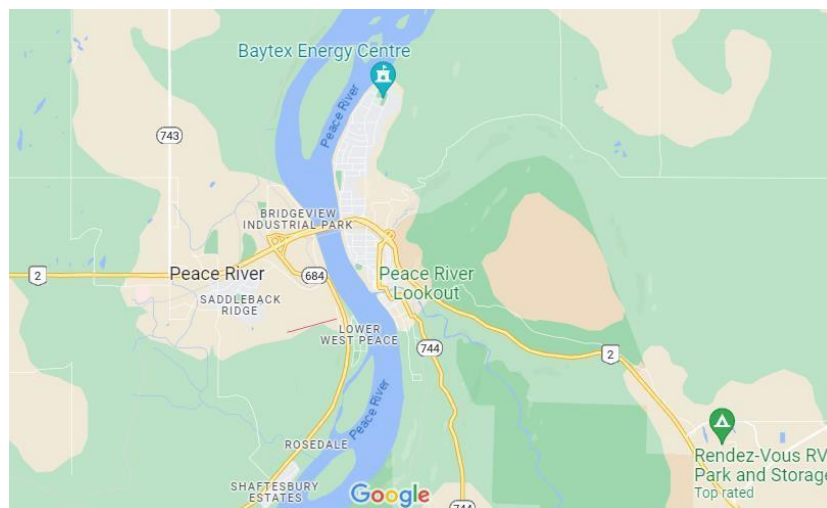

FACILITY INFORMATION

The entire tournament will be held at the Baytex Energy Centre, Peace River. The tournament will be run on two full-sized courts. The round robin and playoff games will be played on Gym 1 and Gym 2. The bronze and gold medal finals will be played on the center court (Gym 2). The spectator viewing gallery is located on the second floor (elevator available). The bleachers will be rearranged for fans to enjoy the championship round at court level. There is ample parking for buses and vehicles.

Registration Process

Registration is to be completed on the championship website ([click here](#)): To fully register, teams will need to do the following:

1. Download and complete the ASAA Provincial Roster Form and save it as an Excel file.
2. Complete the Provincial Championship [Registration Form](#) through Google. Teams will upload the ASAA Provincial Roster Form, player pictures, and a team photo through this medium.
3. Athletic Directors need to ensure that the roster is updated in the ASAA SRS and indicate which athletes are attending provincials.
4. Payment by cheque to École Héritage.

Registration Fees

The registration fee for this event is as follows:

- ASAA Registration Fee- \$560
- Pay it Forward Loonie Fee- \$1 per athlete attending for the ASSA Scholarship Fund.
- Please write one cheque made payable to École Héritage (registration fee, Pay it Forward fee, photography package).

The coaches and captains meeting are **mandatory**. Teams that fail to send a coach to the

meeting will be fined \$250 by ASAA.

Social Activity

Photography

Action shots will be taken during the tournament by Foto Antonio for a fee of \$180 per team. Each team will be provided with a Google Drive of all the photos. To assist the photographer in getting the most action shots possible of every player, **please wear your team jersey at all pre-game warmups.** A waiver form is required for the teams who wish to purchase a photo package. A single consent form must be submitted for the entire team; it is the school's responsibility to attest that each player has provided a FOIP consent form to their respective school. If a player has not given consent, please indicate on the form to ensure that no pictures of the athlete are taken. The consent form can be downloaded from the [championship website](#). The consent form will be included in the tournament welcome email on Monday, Nov. 20th. The form must be submitted by email to Nicole Walisser (nicolewalisser@csno.ab.ca) or on Thursday, Nov. 23rd, prior to the competition. **Private cameras and video cameras are allowed from the viewing gallery.**

Admission

We are happy to welcome spectators to the competition. Spectators can purchase weekend passes for \$10 or a day pass for \$5. **Gate is CASH ONLY.**

Concession/Hospitality Room

Baytex has a concession on site for athletes and fans. The concession is located on the second level (wheelchair accessible - elevator). Coaches and officials will have access to the hospitality room for meals and snacks (located on court level at the east end of the Baytex Centre).

Apparel

Elite Promotional Marketing apparel will be available on site with a variety of items to purchase. Items will also be available online for purchase post-event. The Apparel store will be located at the admission gate on the second floor. **CASH ONLY.**

Change Rooms

There are two designated fieldhouse change rooms for the provincial volleyball athletes. The change rooms will be marked.

Awards

- Champions will receive a banner, medals, a plaque, and t-shirts.
- Runner up will receive silver medals.
- Bronze medal winners will receive medals.
- Sportsmanship award- a sportsmanship committee will be looking for acts of sportsmanship and award pins to athletes. Coaches will receive criteria for sportsmanship and teams will have input as to which team is awarded the sportsmanship banner.
 - The sportsmanship banner is awarded by the ASAA after the event.
 - Coaches, officials, school staff, and athletes may nominate athletes from another school for an individual sportsmanship Set the Bar ASAA award. These will be awarded during the event. Look for nomination posters throughout the Baytex Centre (scan barcode and complete online google form).

First Aid Information and Emergency Action Plan

- A staff member/volunteer that is First Aid certified will be on site for the duration of the tournament. Teams are responsible for bringing their own medical supplies and doing their own taping; however, some medical supplies/ice packs will be available in the PE office in the gym. Ice is available on site- please ask a staff member on site or a concession volunteer for ice.
- Evacuation plans are posted throughout the Baytex Energy Centre.
- The muster place is in the parking lot (south) nearest the aquatic centre.
- In the event of an emergency, the facilities manager or staff member on site will call 9-1-1. Athletes will be taken to the Peace River Hospital.

Grievance Committee and Appeal Process

Any grievances can be brought forward to the Grievance Committee, consisting of Nicole Walisser, Christine Aubin, James Bazan (NWASSA Volleyball Commissioner), and the Head Official. If a coach or athlete wishes to appeal an ejection, it is the responsibility of the Grievance/Discipline Committee to address the appeal as soon as possible, and before the next scheduled game or match. To handle the appeals of an ejection, ASAA policy states:

“All ASAA Provincial Championship Hosts will convene a Discipline/Appeal Committee. The Committee will have the authority to address issues of a serious nature that may occur before, during or after a provincial championship match, or hear appeals of the automatic suspension resulting from an ejection.”

Minor officials (line judges and scorekeepers) are parents and students from École Héritage. Please treat them with respect and understanding; they are volunteering to help make the event run as smoothly as possible.
