

The Tournament at a Glance:

THURSDAY, MARCH 3, 2022



8:30 – 12:00 am Registration :

You can register your team at any time during this time slot. If you wish to get a locker (no charge) you can get the location and combo at this time as well. **Note: there will not be Skips/Coaches meeting as this occurred on Zoom on Feb 28.**

8:40 am Be Ready to Go for Draw 1:

Thirds should find each other and flip to see who has first practice/rock colour. The first practice ice (10 minutes) for this draw will start at 8:40

9:00 – 11:30 DRAW 1

Following the end of Draw 1, another player (other than the one who threw your draw to the button to start of the game) will draw to the button. No practice rock. Sweeping is allowed. This will be added to your initial throw and this cumulative distance will be used to determine the TOP 8 teams that will compete for the Dash for Cash at 3:15.

11:40 Be Ready to Go for Draw 2:

Thirds should find each other and flip to see who has first practice/rock colour. The first practice ice (10 minutes) for this draw will start at 11:40

12:00 – 3:00 DRAW 2

Only for teams that did not play in Draw 1: Following the end of Draw 2, another player (other than the one who threw your draw to the button to start of the game) will draw to the button. No practice rock. Sweeping is allowed. This will be added to your initial throw and this cumulative distance will be used to determine the TOP 8 teams that will compete for the Dash for Cash at 3:00.

3:00 - THE DASH FOR CASH:

The TOP 8 teams who had the combined lowest scores in the draws to the button will come out on the ice. They will select one player to throw for them. Starting with the team in 8th and moving back to the team with the lowest score, their chosen thrower will draw to the button. The four teams with the lowest scores move on. The bottom four get eliminated. Again, in order from the furthest to closest shot (from round one), players throw again. This time, the top 2 advance and the bottom two are eliminated (but each get a \$25 GC). The top two draw to the button. Furthest gets a \$50 GC and the closest gets a \$200 GC!

3:00 Be Ready to Go for Draw 3:

Thirds should find each other and flip to see who has first practice/rock colour. The first practice ice (10 minutes) for this draw will start at 3:10 (or as soon as the Dash for Cash is completed)

3:30 – 6:00 DRAW 3 NOTE: Following the last draw, please help tidy up the rink area before leaving

6:00 - 8:30 NIKKA YUKO VISIT
