GRIEVANCE COMMITTEE

The committee will have the authority to address issues of a serious nature that may occur before, during or after the provincial championships, or to hear appeals of the automatic suspension resulting from an ejection. All grievance issues will also be brought to the attention of ASAA before decision is reached or handed down. Any potential grievance committee members conflict of interest will be taken into account wherever possible.

RULES/POLICY:

It is incumbent upon all coaches and participants to be aware of ASAA Policy. Specifically for this event, player eligibility (pp 37-44), supervision policy (pp 51-52), and basketball policy (pp 81-91).

DISCIPLINE AND MISCONDUCT:

Breaches of the ASAA Code of Ethics are treated seriously, and as host, [we] are required to report any breaches to the ASAA office where action may occur. A portion of the ASAA Code of Ethics states, "Any conduct, including, but not limited to ejections, fighting and drugs and alcohol use, that results in dishonor to the athlete, the team, the school or the ASAA will not be tolerated." (pp 27)

SPORTSMANSHIP:

Sportsmanship is vitally important and highly valued by the ASAA. A Sportsmanship plaque and banner will be awarded to the team that displays appropriate conduct & sportsmanship both individually and at a team level throughout the Championship. Sportsmanship Pins will be handed out throughout the Championship to individual athletes, coaches and/or spectators who display sportsmanship in their words & actions. The sportsmanship committee will be deciding who receives these awards and may consult the officials at the the discretion of the sportsmanship committee.

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PRACTICE/WARM UP BALLS:

Prairie Christian Academy will provide all basketballs for use at the event. This includes balls for practice as well as warm-ups. Please do **NOT** bring your own balls to the school. All basketballs must remain in the gymnasium at all times. We also ask that spectators stay off of the floor during half time to keep the surface clean and safe.

PRACTICE TIMES & TEAM PHOTOS:

All teams will have slots available for practice on Wednesday from 2:30 PM. Each team will be allowed one 60 min. time slot on a court. Practice times are assigned with teams traveling longest distances getting the evening slots.

Team photos for ASAA yearbook and individual athlete and coach (manager, trainer) photos for tournament accreditation lanyards will be taken **prior to your teams practice time (between 2:00 pm and 7:00 pm)** on Wednesday. <u>Photo location for all teams will be at Prairie Christian Academy</u> in **the drama room. 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MEDICAL:

Teams must bring their own medical supplies. Ice will be provided as needed. A registered nurse or designate will be on site all weekend to help with any injury management, or taping and strapping.

CHANGE ROOMS/SHOWER FACILITIES:

Shower facilities and change rooms will be available for use at the gym. No valuables should be left in the change rooms. Each team will be given a change room to meet in at half time. Please note: Prairie Christian Academy is not responsible for lost or stolen articles. Please take your valuables with you after you are done changing.

COACHES/CAPTAINS MEETING:

There will be a coaches meeting at 8:30 AM on Thursday, March 16^{th,} in the Praire Christian Academy Media Lab. There will also be a captains meeting at 8:30 AM in the Foods Lab, located just off of the gathering area. It is mandatory for at least one Coach and Captain from each team to attend these meetings.

<u>The entry fee, banquet fee, and Loonie Scholarship Fee must be brought to</u> <u>the coaches meeting in one cheque.</u>

SCHEDULE/DRAW:

See attached, Appendix A for the schedule as approved by the ASAA. Please note that the highest ranked team will be designated as the Home team and should wear light uniforms. Prairie Christian Academy will always be designated as the home team during the tournament.

OPENING CEREMONIES:

The Opening Ceremonies will take place on Thursday, March 16^{th} @ 9:15 AM in the Prairie Christian Academy gymnasium. Please assemble your team in the Drama Room (where team pictures were taken) by 9:00 AM so we can organize the teams. Please have your athletes come dressed in their uniforms or team apparel.

AWARD/MEDAL PRESENTATIONS:

The consolation plaque, fourth place plaque, third place plaque and bronze medals will be handed out after those games are played. This will allow teams to start heading home if needed. Closing Ceremonies and silver/gold medal presentations will take place after the Championship Game.

COACHES & OFFICIALS ROOM:

A hospitality room will be available for coaches and officials throughout the tournament. A variety of food & beverages will be available. The hospitality room will be located next to the lounge area in the Prairie Christian Academy Staff Room and will be open throughout the tournament.



CONCESSION:

An amazing concession will be available Thursday, Friday and Saturday. The concession can be found in the gathering area.

SPECTATOR ADMISSION/PROGRAM:

Spectators will be required to pay a daily admission. Each day a different colored wrist band will be given and will be non-transferable. Please note that we will not honor wristbands from other Provincial venues and tournaments in the area. PARKING:


GIMMICS



Appendix B – Emergency Action Plan

EMERGENCY ACTION PLAN (EAP)

Please follow and respect the policies and procedures of this Emergency Action Plan (EAP)

While Prairie Christian Academy does everything possible to prevent injuries and accidents at the school, there is still potential for serious accident and injury in any athletic event. If a serious injury occurs, time becomes critical. Subsequently, the implementation of this EAP must be adhered to while in attendance at Prairie Christian Academy events.

Person in Charge:

- Administrator in Charge Mike Callaway
- Tournament Chair Mike Callaway/Bev Olver
- Teacher Supervisors –
- Custodian Ed Yourk

First person on scene of accident:

- Assess injury status of a player (particularly head and/or spinal injuries).
- Contact Person in Charge as soon as possible.
- If an ambulance and paramedics are required the Person in Charge will call **911** if he/she deems it necessary and it hasn't been done yet.
- Person in Charge will take control of an emergency situation until a medical authority arrives.
- Document the events of the accident and file a written report if necessary.

Calling Person in Charge:

- Call Person in Charge (Administrator or Teacher supervisor or Teacher at score table) is responsible for making the **911** telephone call. Teacher supervisors and Teacher at score table are required to have a cell phone on their person while attending an athletic event while at the Prairie Christian Academy.
- Stay in constant communication with the medical provider and the Person in Charge.
- Contact Tournament Chair. Tournament Chair is responsible for having his/her cell phone number available to the call Person in Charge.
- Assist the Person in Charge with the filing of Accident Report if requested.

Control Person:

- The Teacher supervisor and/or other Teachers at the score table are responsible for controlling the crowd and other participants.
- After the area is secured and controlled, the Teacher supervisor will act as the guide for emergency personnel outside of the building to ensure expedient access to the victim.
- Seek highly trained medical personnel in the building if the Person in Charge believes the injury is serious and cannot wait for emergency assistance to arrive.
- In consultation with the Person in Charge, Tournament Chair (if necessary) and game Officials the continuation of play will be determined.
