



## ABOUT ST. PAUL

### The Town

St. Paul, Alberta is located approximately 200 km (2 hours by car) northeast of Edmonton and is home to the world's first UFO Landing Pad. The town has a population of roughly 6,000 (census 2014) made up of various ethnic backgrounds.

### Hotels

In the last couple of years St. Paul has welcomed the newly renovated **Canalta Hotel** (780-645-5581) as well as the recently built **Hampton Inn** (587-465-1300)—both house a pool & water slide. There are also a number of motels in the area.

### Restaurants

Among the three grocery stores (*Sobey's, Extra Foods, CO-OP*), St. Paul also offers a handful of restaurants. These include *Boston Pizza, Burger Baron, the Twisted Fork* and the *Tin Cup* as well as various fast food options such as *Tim Horton's, Subway, McDonalds, A&W, UFO Pizza*, numerous Chinese food options and more.

### Amenities

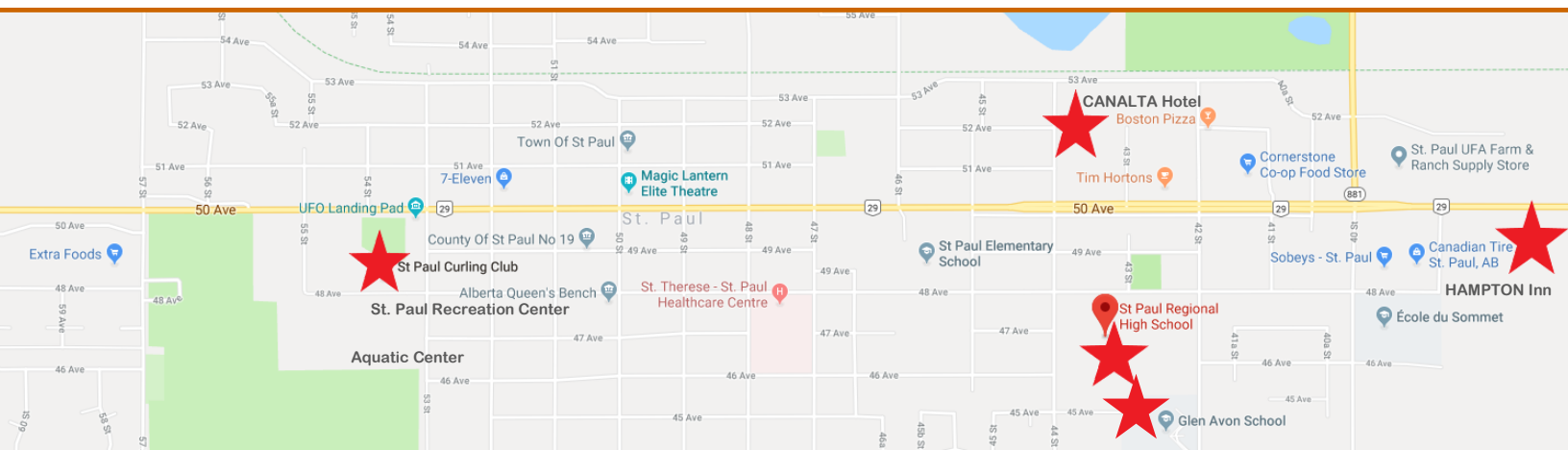
There are a number of useful businesses in the area including *Canadian Tire, Shoppers Drug Mart, Giant Tiger*, a couple of dollar stores, multiple gas stations including *Petro Canada, Husky* and *CO-OP*, and various other local shops.

### Recreation

There are a few indoor recreation options in St. Paul. A movie theatre on main street, a bowling alley, aquatic center with public work-out room (just beside the Recreation Center), and a public library.

### Hospital

Should the need arise, there is a fully equipped hospital and emergency room in the center of town.





## SPECTATORS

### Fees

The entry fee for spectators over the age of 10 is **\$10 per day** or **\$20 for the whole weekend**. *Students and seniors will be \$5/day or \$10/weekend.*

### Parking

During the weekday, parking is available on the street around both schools. In the evenings and over the weekend, parking is also available in the school parking lots.

### Concession

Concessions will be available at both schools throughout the weekend. There are also numerous vending machines on both sites.

### Hotels

Both the CANALTA Hotel and the HAMPTON Inn have **blocks of rooms booked for teams ONLY**. Please do not request these blocked off rooms. If you find that the hotels mentioned are fully booked, there are numerous other motel options in the area to choose from including the St. Paul Lodge, The King's Motel, the Galaxy Motel and more.

## Code of Conduct
