

- Once you click on save content/submit on the bottom of the page, the
 information will be sent to the host. When a confirmation email is
 sent to you, it will include a link back to the registration page
 where you can edit the information, if necessary.

Entry Fee:

The entry fee charged to each team is **\$440** to cover the cost of officials.

Cheques can be made payable to **Bashaw School**. This fee should be submitted at the registration table after your practice at the entry doors.

Banquet:

The banquet will take place at 6:30 pm on Thursday, November 22 at the Bashaw Community Center.. Tickets need to be ordered by 1:00 pm on Monday, November 19th at a cost of \$30 per person. Cheques can be made payable to Bashaw School and paid at the Registration desk with your entry fee on Wednesday. Each team will be allowed to order a maximum of 18 banquet tickets. The banquet will be a suit/tie event where we can dress to impress. Bashaw Community Center is located 5020 52 St.

Our guest speaker will be Kraymer Barnstable. Kraymer was drafted to the Vancouver Giants in 2005. His junior career led him to play for the Notre Dame Hounds and Nipawin Hawks in the SJHL as well as the Lloydminster Bobcats in the AJHL. Kraymer also played for the Everett Silvertips in the WHL. However the highlight of his junior career was a season with the Red Deer Rebels in 2010. After his junior career was completed, Kraymer spent time in the Central Hockey League with the Texas Brahmas. Kraymer then went on to complete 5 years of college & university hockey with the UBC Thunderbirds of the CIS and the Red Deer College Kings in the ACAC. He then went on to play for the Lacombe Generals and was runner up in the 2017 Allan Cup. He is still playing with the Innisfail Eagles in the ACHW. Kraymer is the Goalie Coach for the Red Deer Rebels, as well as has his own goaltender clinic, Stable in the Net.

Our Entertainment for the evening is a performer for Indigo Circus.

Team Rooms/Change Rooms:

School will be in full swing throughout the duration of the tournament. We will be using our change rooms in the gym for the teams. The Boys change room will be designated to the HOME team, and the Girls change room will be GUEST.

Coaches & Officials Room:

The Coaches Room will be located in the Staff Room. The Officials Room will be located in the Conference Room.

Concession:

A concession, serving a variety of hot and cold foods, will be available for the duration of the tournament. The concession will begin close up during the last game of the night. If your team wishes to pre-order, they can pay and it will be ready for pick-up right after the game.

Our goal with our concession will be to donate 30% of our profits to the Stollery.

In addition to this, the town has **Max's** (pizza), **Wongs** (lemon chicken), and the **Bashaw Hotel**(wraps). There is a cozy coffee shop on main street called **Meeting Place Coffee Roasters** (this is our Starbucks).

First Aid Supplies:

Teams are responsible for their own first aid equipment. We have an EMR on call for the duration of the tournament, available for additional support at all times.

Souvenirs:

A Souvenir program will be available at a cost of \$8.00. Clothing will also be on site during our tournament to sell Provincial Clothing. An assortment of styles will be available ranging in price. They will not be printing on site, but instead taking the orders. THIS WILL BE CASH ONLY.

Officials:

The tournament officials are supplied through the cooperation of the Alberta Volleyball Officials Association.

Minor Officials:

Minor officials (line judges and scorekeepers) are students from Bashaw School Sr. High Girls Volleyball Team. Please treat them with respect and understanding; they are volunteering to help make the event run as smoothly as possible.

Hosts:

Each team will be assigned a host for the duration of the tournament. Some of their duties will be to:

- lead each team into the Opening Ceremonies
- act as the team's tour guide and liaison

Protests:

As per ASAA policy, a grievance committee has been organized to handle discipline and appeals. The committee will have the authority to address issues of a serious nature that may occur before, during or after a provincial championship match, or to hear appeals of the automatic suspension resulting from an ejection (see ASAA 2012/13 Policy Handbook). The committee may include, but not be limited to, the tournament chairperson, an official and two coaches not in conflict with the issue. Coaches wishing to volunteer may do so at the coaches meeting. All grievances will be referred to the Tournament Chair who will in turn make a presentation to the Grievance Committee. The decision of this committee is final and not subject to appeal.

Sportsmanship:

A selection committee, including a representative from the officials, will choose the winner of the Sportsmanship Plaque. The presentation of the plaque will be made at the recipient's school at a later date.

Throughout the tournament, the selection committee will also recognize individuals with sportsmanship pins. These pins may be given to players, coaches, parents and spectators who exhibit outstanding displays of integrity, fair play and good sportsmanship.


ASAA Policies:

Coaches are reminded to make themselves aware of the ASAA policy with respect to drugs, alcohol, and tobacco, and the policy referring to teacher supervision.

Local Rules:

- Players are asked to refrain from changing their tops in the gymnasium itself.
- The ASAA prohibits artificial noisemakers at provincial competitions.
 These include, but are not limited to, cow bells, horns, drums, garbage can lids, and plastic bottles filled with coins.
- Abusive behavior including vulgar, obscene language or gestures may be cause for expulsion from the gymnasium.
- Spectators are asked stay off the court in between games.
- All warm-up music will be provided by Bashaw School.

School Map




Town Map
