

Commencing at 9:00am on Thursday, November 24 at Vegreville Composite High School gymnasium. *Please be at the school 30 minutes prior to the opening ceremonies start time to set up for athlete procession*.

Hosts/Hostesses:

Host/Hostesses are assigned to each team to help make your stay in Vegreville an enjoyable one. If you have any questions or concerns, they will be more than willing to assist you or find the person who can.

Souvenirs:

"Gimmics" (official ASAA supplier) will be on site selling various types of tournament souvenir apparel. They will be set up in the cafeteria at VCHS.

Teams are NOT required to bring pins for exchange. If they wish to exchange or give items they may do so.

Team Pictures:

R. Pond will be taking all team pictures prior to the Wednesday practice in the Cougar Council room at VCHS (Host/Hostesses will guide teams to the photo shoot).

Catherine Page will be taking action shots during the tournament. She has offered to provide all team game photos/individual action shots on a CD at the cost of \$100.00/team (optional).

Awards Ceremonies:

Medal presentations will be made immediately following each of the medal matches.

Admission/Programs:

The admission for the tournament will be \$8 per day or \$15 for the weekend. Students and Seniors will be \$5 per day or \$10 for the weekend.

Programs will be sold at the front gate for \$5.

Practice Times:

Practice times are available on Wednesday, November 23rd from 3:00-8:00pm at Vegreville Composite High and St. Mary's Catholic School. This allows 1 hour practice sessions for each team. Times will be given in order in which they are received. Please email requests to Adrienne Mills at <u>adrienne.mills@eips.ca</u> by noon on Monday, November 21st. You will *NOT* receive an email reply; practice schedule will be posted Tuesday, November 22nd on the host website. *Note:* All team photos will be taken 30 minutes prior to the assigned practice time at Vegreville Composite High School (even if you are practicing at St. Mary's).

Tie Breaking Procedure:

Team Requirements:

Each team is responsible for their own warm-up balls.

Change Rooms:

Due to the school being in session on Thursday and Friday, team rooms will be assigned. Host/Hostesses will ensure they are always locked.

Coaches are reminded that they are responsible for their team's behavior on and off the court while in the school. Please, no warming up in the hallways or change rooms.

Hospitality Room:

Food and beverages will be available, for coaches and officials in the hospitality room, which is located in Room 18 in VCHS.

Concessions are available at both schools with many healthy food choices for your athletes and their fans.

Local Rules:

Coaches are asked to inform their players of the following:

- 1. The school is not responsible for any lost articles. Please inform your players that in order to safeguard valuables they must be given to coach or other reliable person.
- 2. Athletes are to be in designated areas only, as regular classes are in session Thursday and Friday.
- 3. Athletes are to use the change rooms or washrooms closest to the court to change from their warm-up gear to their uniform as no changing is permitted at the bench as per ASAA recommendations.

Parking:

Due to school in session Thursday and Friday, team buses are to park across the street, North West of VCHS in the ALCLUB BINGO HALL parking lot or on the street. At St. Mary's venue, please park in the field in front of the school or on the street. On Saturday, parking will be available in the student and staff parking lots or on the street. See attached map for more details.

Sportsmanship:

An observing Sportsmanship Committee consisting of school staff and parents will award sportsmanship pins thought the tournament. The Provincial Sportsmanship Banner will be determined by the Sportsmanship Committee tally, and will be presented along with the Sportsmanship Plague to the winning school at a later date.

Minor Officials:

Scorekeepers and line judges will be provided for each match. Please treat them with respect.

First Aid:

Coaches are responsible for having all pertinent medial information for their own tournament participants. Please remember to bring parental contact information, Alberta Health Care numbers, as well as information and supplies relevant to allergies and injuries (i.e. epi-pens). Teams must bring their own medical supplies and plan to do their own taping. Ice is available upon request.

Emergency Action Plan (EAP):

There will be first aid kits in the Phys. Ed offices in VCHS and St. Mary's gym. In an emergency a telephone can be used in the Phys. Ed office or main office. In case of an emergency phone 911. An individual with first aid training will be available throughout the tournament to assist with injuries. Designated individuals will be assigned to help direct the ambulance and control the crowd in the event of a more serious injury.


