MEDICAL

- 911 will be initiated when needed.

PERSONAL SAFETY

Inclement Weather	High Winds, lightning, tornadoes, heavy hail, extreme heat. Equipment that could blow over (i.e. Tents)	Secure equipment, Gather at muster point
Dehydration	Not enough intake of water	Paramedic Station will be stocked with bottled water for use in an emergency
Fire	Lightning, cigarettes	Fire extinguisher on site at clubhouse, notify Trochu Fire Department of event
