Emergency Medical Procedures

1. If someone using the Physical Education facilities develops or sustains a serious medical emergency:
 - if you are trained in first aid or CPR, provide initial first aid (assess and commence life-support management).
 - dial 911
 - let a college employee know about the incident as soon as possible
 - 911 will ask "What is your emergency?" (police, fire, medical)
 - stay on the line and follow instructions
 - provide the site details:
 - phone: 403 382-6903
 - address: 3000 College Drive S.
 - special directions: Physical Education Building
 - send someone outside to meet the responding emergency personnel.
Alert Security or Maintenance to be on site when EMS arrives.
 - advise Health Centre personnel of the situation (ext. 3289)
 - fill in an incident report (found in photocopy room and PE check-in area) and return to staff in PE check-in area
2. If the injury is non-life threatening, treat and arrange transportation to the college Health Centre, Chinook Regional Hospital or a walk-in clinic. Fill in an incident report (found in PE check-in area) and return to staff in PE check-in area
