

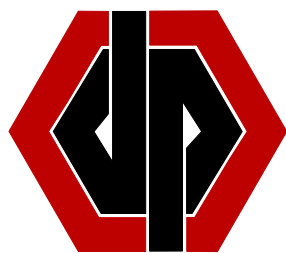

When completing the online registration, the following information must also be provided: how many tournament banquet tickets are required for your team (Banquet tickets are \$25/person. A maximum of 18 tickets are available to each team).

Team registration must be completed by Monday, November 18TH at 12:00 noon.

Team fees must be paid prior to the banquet on Wednesday, November 20th.

Banquet/Official Opening:

The official opening of the tournament will be held in conjunction with the banquet on Wednesday, November 20th at 7:00pm – 9:00pm at Jasper Place High School in the Cafeteria. Attendance at the banquet/opening ceremonies is compulsory for all team members and coaches. Teams must wear attire that identifies them as a team.

Tickets are \$25/person with a maximum of 18 tickets allowed per team. Tickets must be paid for at time of registration.

The banquet will include opening comments by ASAA executive members, words of inspiration via a guest speaker Carolyn O'Dwyer, and a full meal.

Pay it Forward Loonie Fee:

Just a reminder to all schools that this past year, as voted on and approved by the Board at the AGM, there will be a 'Pay It Forward Loonie Fee' assessed to all participants at provincials. This fee will be added to all provincial registration form on the tournament website.

The Pay it Forward Loonie Fee – states that “each provincial championship will charge an additional \$1 for each participating student and remit those funds to the ASAA office after the championship. Those funds will be directed to the ASAA scholarship fund to recognize student athletes who give back to their school and communities by either coaching or officiating in school or community sport.”

Photos:

All teams are expected to get team photos and individual photos done Wednesday, November 20th. Photos will take place at Jasper Place High School (room 152) on a first come, first serve basis starting at noon (12:00pm – 6:15 pm).

Teams are requested to appear for photos with consistency of team gear. Player numbers **must** be visible in the photo.

We will not be doing individual photos, when the team is ready in their team gear the photo will only take 2-3 minutes.

Warm-up Volleyball/Practice Sessions:

All teams are required to provide their own volleyballs for practice/warm-up

For visiting teams, practice times will be accommodated in one-hour blocks for Wednesday, November 20th, beginning at 10:30 am. Times will be allocated based on your zone and the distance you travel to get here. Teams may begin booking practice times online on Monday November 18th at 10:00am.

There will be a link to the online form on the website at that time.

Coaches/Captains Meetings:

These will be held at Jasper Place High School the evening of Wednesday, November 20th @ 9:15pm. All teams must have a representative present.

First Aid:

Teams must provide their own medical supplies and plan to do their own taping. We will have a trainer's room set up at Jasper Place High School. Ice will be available upon request. Tournament Organizing Committee members will be available to assist you in accessing further medical attention if required.

Hospitality/Concession:

Jasper Place High School will operate a concession.

A Hospitality room will be provided by the Organizing Committee at Jasper Place High School. We ask cooperation in ensuring that these rooms be utilized by, essentially, adults-only – coaches, officials, and organizers. They are intended as informal and friendly respites for participants and we request that criticisms/complaints (if any) be aired in more private areas.

Tournament Souvenirs:

Clothing sales will take place at Jasper Place High School and will be provided while quantities last. Elite Promotional Marketing is our official clothing sponsor and has provided us with the clothing for this event. The price range for the clothing is TBA. Cash will be the only method of payment accepted.

Awards Presentations:

All “presentation games” will be held at Jasper Place High School and awards will be presented immediately following. These include Championship, Finalists, 3rd Place, 4th Place, and Consolation Championship. In accord with ASAA, Team Sportsmanship Awards will be presented by the ASAA to the recipient school at a time shortly after the competition.

Sportsmanship:

Consistent with ASAA values, a strong emphasis on and recognition of sportsmanship in both individual and teams will be highlighted. The Sportsmanship Committee will award individual pins in recognition of sportsmanship-like actions through the tournament, and will forward recommendation for the Team Award to the ASAA for later presentation.

The Sportsmanship Committee will be comprised of members of the Organizing Committee as well as a representative voice from the AVOA.

Discipline and Misconduct:

Breaches of the ASAA Code of Ethics are treated seriously and, as hosts, we are required to immediately report to the ASAA office any breaches that come to our attention. A portion of the ASAA Code of Ethics states "Any conduct, including, but not limited to ejections, fighting, drugs and alcohol use, that results in dishonor to the athlete, the team, the school or the ASAA will not be tolerated." (pg. 29)

Coaches and/or athletes who have been ejected from a game will be required to leave the school premises for the duration of that match.

Grievance/Discipline Committee:

A Grievance/Discipline Committee will be in place to review any and all concerns that may occur. These will include appeals of application of ASAA policy (e.g. automatic game suspension for ejection of an athlete or coach), as well as tournament concerns. This Committee will be comprised of two members of the host committee.

Code of Ethics/Sportsmanship:

We remind all about the standards of behavior and performance for which the ASAA stands – applying the team's members as well as supporters. Fair play and sportsmanship of team members are expectations of the ASAA and the Organizing Committee, and the responsibility of coaches. A reminder that artificial noisemakers are not allowed at ASAA events. While hosts will monitor and address unacceptable spectator behavior, we will – if necessary – call on team delegates to assist with their fans.

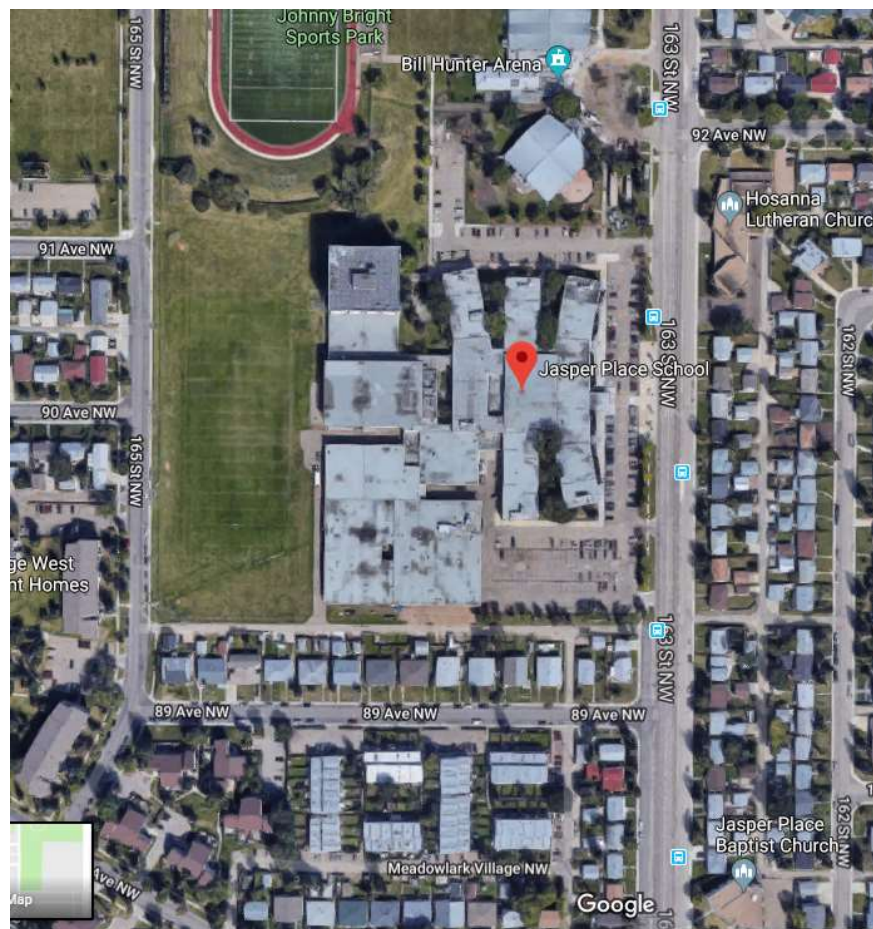
A reminder that a coach or player that is disqualified will receive a one game suspension. If it is the teacher sponsor that is disqualified, and no other teacher sponsor is available for that team, the team will not be allowed to participate in their following game.
