TEAM PHOTOS AND ACCREDITATION

TEAM PRACTICES

- Following the photo session will be a timed 45 minute Team Practice.
- Practices will be held at J. R. Robson.

- Teams are to complete their practice on time to allow the next team their allotted time.

• Do NOT bring basketballs to the tournament. They will be provided for the Team Practice session as well as the warm ups.

DRAW

- The participating teams in the tournament will be ranked/seeded by the ASAA.
- The tournament organizers have no control over seeding the tournament draw.
- The final draw with team names allocated with their appropriate seeds will be posted on the website by Tuesday March 17th.
- Game results and score sheets will be posted on the Tournament website throughout the tournament.





CHANGE ROOMS

• Classrooms will be available as change rooms, prior to the game, at half time and after the game. They will be designated as Home or Away and you will be assigned one prior to your game.

• DO NOT leave valuables in the change rooms. J.R. Robson is not responsible for any lost or stolen items.

GAME TIME PROCEDURES

• Remain off the court until the floor has been swept and the teams have vacated their bench with their belongings. The court will be swept prior to each game and at half time.

- Dunking, without excessive hanging on the rim, will be allowed in warm up.
- Identify the starters on the score sheet so they can be introduced prior to the start of the game.
- Games will not begin prior to the scheduled start time.

SPORTSMANSHIP

• The Sportsmanship Committee will be comprised of members of the Organizing Committee as well as a representative voice from the ABOA.

• The Sportsmanship Committee will award individual pins in recognition of sportsmanship-like actions through the tournament.

• They will forward a recommendation for the Team Award to the ASAA for later presentation.

DISCIPLINE & MISCONDUCT

• Breaches of the ASAA Code of Ethics are treated seriously and, as hosts, we are required to immediately report to the ASAA office any breaches that come to our attention. A portion of the ASAA Code of Ethics states "Any conduct, including, but not limited to ejections, fighting, drugs and alcohol use, that results in dishonor to the athlete, the team, the school or the ASAA will not be tolerated."

• Coaches and/or athletes who have been ejected from a game will be required to leave the school premises for the duration of that match.

GRIEVANCE/DISCIPLINE COMMITTEE

• A Grievance/Discipline Committee will be in place to review any and all concerns that may occur. These will include appeals of application of ASAA policy (e.g. automatic game suspension for ejection of an athlete or coach), as well as tournament concerns.





• We remind all about the standards of behavior and performance for which the ASAA stands – applying the team's members as well as supporters. Fair play and sportsmanship of team members are expectations of the ASAA and the Organizing Committee, and the responsibility of coaches.

• While hosts will monitor and address unacceptable spectator behavior, we will – if necessary – call on team delegates to assist with their fans.

• A reminder that artificial noisemakers are not allowed at ASAA events.

• If a coach or player that is disqualified will receive a one game suspension. If it is the teacher sponsor that is disqualified, and no other teacher sponsor is available for that team, the team will not be allowed to participate in their following game.



PARKING




 NO PARKING – FIRE LANE

Emergency Procedures:

MEDICAL

-Contact Person in Charge

-Person in Charge will initiate First Aid and Contact EMR -Medical personnel (EMR) on call will be contacted by 2 way radio - 2 way radio

is at the basketball score table

-First aid will be administered

-911 will be called if the medical emergency requires their assistance

-Teacher supervisors and/or other persons in charge are responsible for controlling the crowd and other participants

-EMR has emergency Epi-Pens

FIRE

In the event of a fire alarm, the emergency fire alarm panels emit a sound and begin to blink. All patrons of the building are to exit the building by the nearest emergency exit. All classrooms have emergency exit maps and emergency exits are clearly marked throughout the school. Once outside, patrons will then proceed to muster point 1 (out main doors to West of school and across the street), or muster point 2 (large garage at East of school- in the case of extremely cold weather) until emergency services have been called and deemed it safe to re-enter the facility.

Tournament Chair and Co-chair will take charge at Muster point 1, contact school administration and liaison with Emergency crews. All patrons are not to enter the building again until the building is cleared by Emergency crews and the Tournament Chair has advised that it is safe to do so.

LOCKDOWN


