Coaches and Captains Meeting:

Thursday, November 23rd at 8:30 am. Coaches will meet in Room 109 and Captains will meet in VC Room. Attendance is mandatory. Tournament details to be discussed and any questions or concerns may be addressed at the meeting.

Team Rosters:

Roster and team pictures must be submitted using the online registration tool. If possible, please include a picture of your school crest by Monday, November 20th, 2017 at noon.

It is extremely important to have this information in Monday if you wish to have your team listed in the official program. All registration is to be done online on the ASAA host website by clicking the registration link.

There are four forms to complete: Team Roster, Team History, Team Photo and Team Order Form. Instructions for these forms are on the website. **Pictures must be high quality and in jpg format (minimum 7 megapixels, with no digital zoom). Team Logos are to be submitted in EPS format or as a PDF.**

Banquet Program:

Each team is asked to take part in minute to win it games. There will also be a photo booth for teams to take part in, \$1.00 per print.

Five additional tickets per team will be made available for parents who wish to attend.

Theme for the banquet is Canada 150!. Come dressed to show your Canadian pride!

Banquet tickets are ordered on the team order form in the online registration process and attendance is mandatory. The banquet tickets are \$25.00 per person.

Opening Ceremonies:

Commencing at 9:30am on Thursday, November 23 Fairview High School gymnasium. Please be at the school 30 minutes prior to the opening ceremonies start time to set up for athlete procession.

Hosts/Hostesses:

Host/Hostesses are assigned to each team to help make your stay in Fairview an enjoyable one. If you have any questions or concerns, they will be more than willing to assist you or find the person who can.

Souvenirs:

"Gimmicks" (official ASAA supplier) will be on site selling various types of tournament souvenir apparel. They will be set up in Room 109 at FHS.

Teams are NOT required to bring pins for exchange. If they wish to exchange or give items they may do so.

Medal presentations will be made immediately following each of the medal matches.

Admission/Programs:

The admission for the tournament will be \$10 per day or \$20 for the weekend. Students and seniors will be \$5 per day or \$10 for the weekend. Families may purchase a weekend pass for \$50.

Programs will be sold at the front gate for \$5.

Practice Times:

Practice times will be available from 2:00 pm until 8:00pm and will occur at FHS Court #1 and Court #2.

Tie Breaking Procedure:

As per ASAA rules is laid out in the ASAA 2017-2018 Policy Handbook.

Team Requirements:

Each team is responsible for their own warm-up balls.

Change Rooms:

Due to the school being in session on Thursday and Friday, Teams will be asked to change in the change room or in the classroom provided at FHS. These will be assigned to the teams at the conclusion of the match 2 games before theirs. The team host will be given keys for the rooms so that team gear will be locked up.

AT EEO, there are only 2 change rooms, behind the benches. As these cannot be locked, the players are asked to take their belongings and put them behind the benches. Teams will be assigned one of these two rooms for each game.

Coaches are reminded that they are responsible for their team's behaviour on and off the court while in the school. Please, no warming up in the hallways or change rooms.

Hospitality Room:

There will be a hospitality room for coaches and referees in the staff room at FHS. Refreshments will be provided at EEO but no room is available.

Concession:

A cafeteria will be run at Fairview High School with many healthy food choices for your athletes and their fans.

Local Rules:

Coaches are asked to inform their players of the following:

1. The school is not responsible for any lost articles. Please inform your players that in order to safeguard valuables they must be given to coach or other reliable person.
2. Athletes are to be in designated areas only, as regular classes are in session Thursday and Friday.
3. Athletes are to use the change rooms assigned to change from their warm-up gear to their uniform **as no changing is permitted at the bench as per ASAA recommendations.**

Parking:

Parking for spectators at Fairview High will be in the parking lot directly south of the school. There will be NO parking in the bus loop in front of the school for safety. The bus loop can be used drop off or pick up players.

Bus parking for teams at Fairview High will be at the Fairview Bus Garage, which is located 2 blocks south of the school.

At EE Oliver Parking:

for cars will be limited to 103rd and 105th Avenues. (signs will be placed on 104th Avenue and 112th Street indicating this)

Bus drop off will be in bus loop (excluding 3:00 pm to 3:50 pm)

Bus parking for teams at EE Oliver School will be in the designated area to the east of the school on 104th Avenue.

Sportsmanship:

An observing Sportsmanship Committee consisting of school staff and parents will award sportsmanship pins throughout the tournament. The Provincial Sportsmanship Banner will be determined by the Sportsmanship Committee tally, and will be presented along with the Sportsmanship Plaque to the winning school at a later date.

Minor Officials:

Scorekeepers and line judges will be provided for each match. Please treat them with respect.

First Aid:

Coaches are responsible for having all pertinent medical information for their own tournament participants. Please remember to bring parental contact information, Alberta Health Care numbers, as well as information and supplies relevant to allergies and injuries (i.e. epi-pens). Teams must bring their own medical supplies and plan to do their own taping. Ice is available upon request.

Live Streaming:

Live streaming of all games will be available on the host website under the live streaming link. Please note that this service, as of last year, will be at a cost to the spectators.

Emergency Action Plan (EAP):

There will be first aid kits in the Phys. Ed offices in FHS and EEO gym. In an emergency a telephone can be used in the Phys. Ed office or main office. In the case of an emergency phone 911. An individual with first aid training will be available throughout the tournament to assist with injuries. Designated individuals will be assigned to help direct the ambulance and control the crowd in the event of a more serious injury.

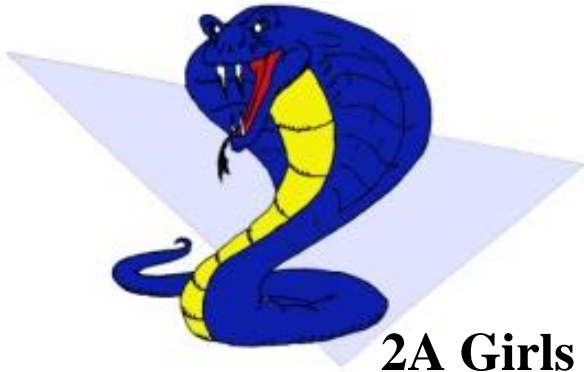
