# Spectator Info

## **Admission and Parking:**

There will be one entrance gate on the south side of the school for walk on only. The south school parking lot will be marked for buses and vehicles.

Admission is set at the following:

Adults \$10.00 per day Students \$5.00 per day Children Under 10 FREE

There will be NO Tournament passes or Family rate

No dogs are allowed on site.

There will be limited parking for all other vehicles and these will be on a first come first served basis (after volunteers and officials have parked).

All parking is at your own risk, any damages, vandalism or theft is not the responsibility of the school

The access gate is located at the north west corner of the parking lot and is manned by gate attendees.

\*\*Participants are reminded to keep their Participant Pass on them at all times.

Participants without their Participant Pass will be charged the entry fee to access the facilities.

There will be food and beverages available for spectators at the BBQ behind the football tower.

#### Concession

Realize that your attendance is a privilege to attend and watch a match and support high school athletics, not a license to verbally assault players, coaches or officials. We hope the spectators will watch, enjoy, encourage and be proud of us, win or lose. We need your support and enthusiasm, not your yelling and criticism."
