<u>Spectator Admission Rates & Programs</u>

Parking

Thursday, parking will be limited as school is in session. Parking is available in the front or back parking lot, on the streets and residential areas surrounding the school. Please adhere to the reserved parking signs in the back parking lot at Notre Dame on Thursday. **DO NOT PARK IN THE LOADING ZONE for BUSES at THE FRONT OF THE SCHOOL on THURSDAY**. Parking spaces are fine, but no parking in the bus loop (note bus loop parking will be used between 12:15pm and 12:40pm on Thursday and entry or exit with vehicles will be unavailable). Fan Expectations

Spectators, both student and adult, must demonstrate courtesy and good sportsmanship by positive cheers of encouragement for their

team, not against the opposing team. This is evidenced by the absence of booing and vulgarities. Spectators must also show proper acceptance of officials' judgment. Artificial noisemakers are not permitted during provincial championship tournaments/events. These noisemakers may include but are not limited to: air horns, cow bells, plastic tube horns, garbage can lids, etc. The provincial championship host shall have the authority to eject from the competition facility individuals who, following a warning, refuse to comply with this requirement.

Fan's Yellow Card

This yellow card is being given to you as a warning that your behavior may not be appropriate for this educational setting. Realize that your attendance is a privilege to attend and watch a match and support high school athletics, not a license to verbally assault players, coaches or officials. High school student athletes helped write the following message for you: "It's not your game, it's ours, the athletes that are competing. We hope the spectators will watch, enjoy, encourage and be proud of us, win or lose. We need your support and enthusiasm, not your yelling and criticism."
