

#### Fees

The entry fee for spectators is \$5 per day or \$10 for the whole weekend.

# Code of Conduct

- Consistently give positive feedback to players and others.
- Respect participants, coaches and fans.
- Present positive comments before, during and after the game. Spectators, both student and adult, must demonstrate courtesy and good sportsmanship by positive cheers of encouragement for their team, not against the opposing team. This is evidenced by the absence of booing and vulgarities.
- Be helpful to others (i.e. willingly offer information about the game, score, scheduling, venue locations, etc. to onlookers)
- Spectators must also show proper acceptance of officials' judgment.

"The ideals of good sportsmanship, ethical behavior and integrity should permeate all interscholastic athletics in our community.

In perception and practice, good sportsmanship shall be defined as those qualities of behavior which are characterized by generosity and genuine concern for others.

Our athletic fields should be the laboratory to produce good citizens reflecting fair play in every area of life."
