Parking

Please ensure your team has at least one student representative and one adult representative at this meeting to receive pertinent information regarding the provincial championships.

Team Apparel

Elite is the ASAA's official supplier of championship souvenir apparel for all ASAA Championships. Items will be for sale throughout the tourney at the Apparel Booth located in the front lobby. Athletes will also be able to order personalized gear online through-out the tourney, to be delivered to them in the weeks following the event. Game Balls

The official game balls will be Alberta Team Handball Federation approved Size 2 ball (boys) and Size 1 ball (girls).

Team Hosts

Hosts will be assigned to each team to help make your stay in Diamond Valley an enjoyable one. If you have any questions or problems, they will be more than willing to assist you or find a person who can.

Team Rooms/Change Rooms/ Showers

Shower facilities and change rooms will be available for use in the gym prior to and after your game. No valuables should be left in the change rooms. Each team will be given a change room to meet in at half time. Selected classrooms at Oilfields High School will be available for Friday evening & Saturday. Please note: Oilfields High School is not responsible for lost or stolen articles. Please ensure valuables are safely stored.

Coaches & Officials Room:

A hospitality room will be available for coaches and officials throughout the tournament. A variety of food & beverages will be available. The hospitality room will be in the school library. There will be a separate room for referee meetings and evaluations. Coaches are encouraged to talk to refs privately over issues and questions and keep the hospitality room to social discussions and encouragement.

Rules/Policy

It is incumbent upon all coaches and participants to be aware of ASAA Policy. Specifically for this event, please ensure you're aware of player eligibility, supervision policy, and the Team Handball policy.

Discipline & Misconduct

Breaches of the ASAA Code of Ethics are treated seriously, and as host, Oilfields High School is required to report any breaches to the ASAA office where action may occur. A portion of the ASAA Code of Ethics states, "Any conduct, including, but not limited to ejections, fighting and drugs and alcohol use, that results in dishonor to the athlete, the team, the school or the ASAA will not be tolerated."

Grievance Committee

There are two key functions of the Grievance/Discipline Committee at ASAA provincials. The first function is to deal with matters that occur during competition, typically discipline/conduct issues, and appeals that may arise from ejections. The second function is to handle any other matters that arise that require dispute resolution. A reminder that a coach or player disqualified will receive a one-game suspension. If it is the teacher/supervisor that is disqualified, and no other teacher/supervisor is available for that team, the team will not be allowed to participate in their following game.

Sportsmanship

Sportsmanship is vitally important and valued by the ASAA.
