Modifications to 2021-22 Volleyball 4A Rankings

Dear ASAA Member Schools:

With the support of the ASAA Volleyball Commissioners, the ASAA is suspending 4A volleyball rankings for the 2021/2022 season. This decision to suspend volleyball rankings was made due to insufficient cross-zone competition for the ASAA rankings committee to produce a fair ranking of teams. The 4A volleyball rankings will return in the 2022/2023 volleyball season.

As a result, the process for allocating vacant berths and the format of the ASAA 4A Volleyball Provincial Championship will be modified to account for the inability to establish accurate team rankings. For the 2021/2022 season only, the championship format will use the same procedures as 2A/3A volleyball, outlined in ASAA Policy Section XIX.4.II 2A & 3A Format:

Two pools of six will be determined by the Volleyball Commissioners using the summary of volleyball provincial seeding. At the completion of the round robin, the top three teams from each section will advance to an elimination match; the first place team from each section receives a bye, the second place teams play the third place teams from the opposite section. The winners of the two matches play the first place teams to determine the finalists. All round robin and playoff games shall consist of rally point scoring, the best two of three games; first two to 25 points, third game to 15 points, all played to a two point difference with no cap.
