Re: Basketball Wildcard Allocations

The ASAA awards wildcards to zones in basketball as per policies X.7 $\&\,8.$

The 2023 wildcards are awarded as follows:

^{*}No other zones have a second team ranked in the top 10 or HM, so Central receives a 2nd wildcard.

^{**}Calgary does not have a representative for 3A girls, which creates a vacant berth. As per policy X.7.D, this berth goes to Edmonton.

^{***}Calgary does not have four teams in the top 15, so cannot qualify for a wildcard. Based on policy, this becomes a vacant berth, which goes to the South.

^{****}The North East Zone has no 4A teams which creates a vacant berth. The highest ranked zone is South for girls and Edmonton for boys, so those zones receive the vacant berths.

^{****}Edmonton cannot receive the vacant boys berth as they already have five representatives (including the host), therefore, Calgary receives the vacant berth.
