Re: Reinstatement of ASAA Restrictions Regarding Non-school Team Play

Note: This replaces the September 29, 2020 Memo

MEMO

The ASAA Executive Committee has determined that effective November 1, 2020, the temporary lift of ASAA Policy Section IV.5 Participation on a non-school team announced on September 29 will not continue for team sports other than volleyball, which has about four weeks of its season of play remaining.

This means that students may not play on a school and a non-school team at the same time as per the following policy:

To be eligible for high school participation in the ASAA Sports of volleyball, football, cheerleading, team handball and rugby, a high school student is not permitted to play on a non-school team in the same sport during the same season (note: individual sports are not impacted by this policy)

Basketball: Please note that current ASAA policy allows students to continue playing club/community basketball until either their school team is chosen, or the final day of volleyball provincials (midnight November 28, 2020), whichever comes first as per the following policy:

ASAA Policy Section IV.5.A Participation on a non-school team: Where a community/club basketball program exists, students are permitted to play for the community/club basketball team while trying out for an ASAA member school team but can no longer play for the community/club team as of the school team's first game, or midnight of the Saturday of volleyball provincials, whichever comes first.
