Re: MileSplit Network

ASAA Athletic Directors and Track & Field Coaches,

Thank you to everyone who attended the Virtual Town Hall with our partners at MileSplit: here is a <u>link to the meeting recording</u> in case you missed it or would like to review.

The ASAA office would like to clarify the process for schools:

- 1. Register all of your track & field athletes in SRS as you normally would.
- 2. Within three work days, all athletes that were registered in SRS will have been inputted into MileSplit.
- 3. On <u>ab.MileSplit.com</u>, register your athletes for their specific events in their eligible meet.

FLEXIBLE REGISTRATION OPTION available this spring (2023): Schools that have not yet registered their athletes in SRS have the option of first registering their students through MileSplit. However, note that in order to be eligible to compete at zones, students must be registered in SRS. Also note that teams must be registered in SRS by May 15 (at least one athlete as per policy). Effective for the 2024 season and beyond, in order for a student to be eligible to compete, they must first be registered in SRS.
