Re: ASAA Clarification regarding Outreach Schools/Joint school programs

The ASAA office has been asked to provide clarification regarding students from Outreach schools playing on a joint school team for another school. Please note for **ASAA TEAM SPORTS**:

- Outreach Schools must be members of the ASAA in order for any of their students to be considered eligible to participate in any ASAA high school athletic activity at any level (local league, exhibition, tournaments, zones, provincials)
- When an Outreach school joins another ASAA member school (known as the Primary school) to form a joint school team, the ASAA declared student populations for each school are added together to determine the classification/tier at which the team will compete.
 - **MISINFORMATION:** Someone has been informing students and/or Outreach schools that only the Outreach student(s) playing have to be added to the population of the Primary school – this is incorrect. Every ASAA eligible student from Gr. 10-12 at the Outreach school must be added to the Primary school to determine classification; SRS will do this automatically.
- The Primary School must first register their team in SRS where they will note from a pull down menu, the name of the school(s), Outreach of other, who they are joining with.
- When the above step is completed, the Outreach school must register any student who is going to be on that joint school program. The same registration deadlines apply to the Outreach school as apply to the Primary School
- The Primary school **does not** register the Outreach student in SRS under any circumstance.





Please note for **INDIVIDUAL SPORTS** (golf, cross-country, badminton, wrestling, track & field):

- An Outreach student **can only compete for the Outreach school** – they cannot be registered by, or compete for, any other school at any time local league, exhibition, tournaments, zones, provincials.
